In 1923, the trustees of the school were William Gray, Jim Cooper, and L. B. Daniel, Similax.

The school was still operating in the 1930s because two items about the school are found in the Progressive Age:

May 23, 1935: Adele Rivers visited the school, student account

Nov 4, 1937: House's Bargain House provided flags for the school

In 1886, Island Creek was an election district. Also called Gross' Spring

In 1890, It was considered a Methodist circuit

In 1897, county taking bids to operate a ferry at the mouth of Island creek on the TN River
