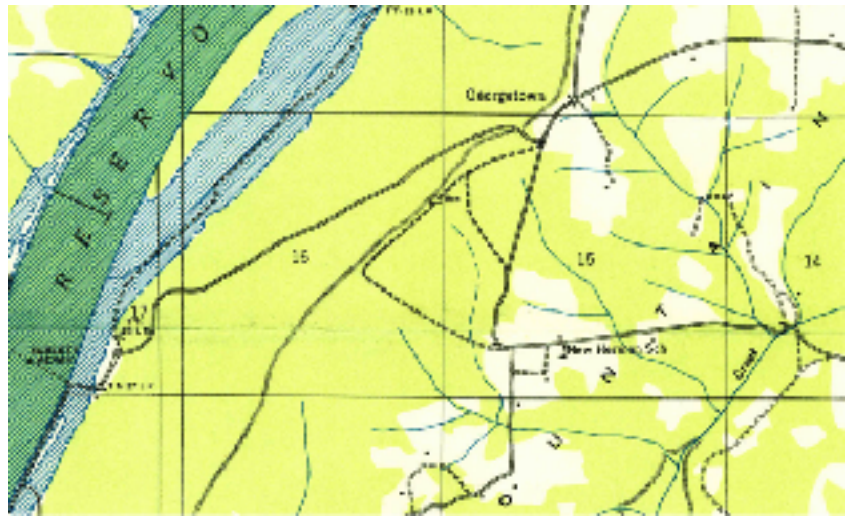


## New Herman School

Rayburn Casey Hall New Herman was aka, Lizardlope school, three miles west of Pisgah, Alabama on Co RD 88 My Dad, Fred Hall, started to school at the New Herman (Lizardlope) school. He was born in May 1924. He should have started about 1930.

My mother went to the Herman School for a few months, but it was much before 1938, the year I was born. Miss Alley Roden was her teacher. This building was around the curve about a quarter of a mile from the New Herman Church. I don't recall it being called Lizard Lope at the time. It's strange how certain names--some not too flattering--stick.

**Nov 11, 1915 SC:** Prof. J. M. Langston and Mr. Walter Gant attended church at New Herman Sunday.

**Feb 25, 1926 PA:** Allie L. Roden at New Herman (no district number) was paid \$127.50 for teaching.

**Sep 20, 1928 PA:** "Miss Hula Caves began teaching at New Herman Monday."

**Dec 19, 1929 PA:** "Miss Ista Wright is teaching at New Herman."

**Mar 27, 1930 PA:** New Herman recognized for its exceptionally high attendance—90.09%.

**Feb 5, 1931 PA:** New Herman recognized for high attendance.

**Jan 17, 1935 PA:** New Herman attendance reported at 57%.

**Jul 4, 1935 PA:** Contracts for school bus routes let. Route 15 was Central, New Herman, to Pisgah.

**Nov 10, 1938 PA:** County Schools Financial Report. Leon Adams and Sartin and Sartin each paid \$1.50 for wood for New Herman School.

**Jan 26, 1939 PA:** 1939 Educational directory recognizes Mrs. Hula Starkey as the teacher at Herman School.

**Jul 18, 1940:** County Board of Education ordered a trustee election for a number of school, including New Herman.

**Nov 28, 1940 PA:** Attendance Report for Jackson County Schools says that 43 students are registered for New Herman School, but the average daily attendance is 26.

**May 1, 1941:** New Herman is one of the school participating in the County Extension Service program for creating cotton mattresses. A center was set up at the school and New Herman had created 31 so far.

**May 15, 1941 PA:** Typhoid clinic at New Herman School. Also May 22 and Jul 16, 1942.

**Jul 18, 1948 PA:** Rabies vaccinations at New Herman Church (not school).

**May 4, 1950 PA:** School Supplements. One of the buses serving Pisgah School picked up from New Herman.

All further references to the New Herman community are to New Herman Church.
