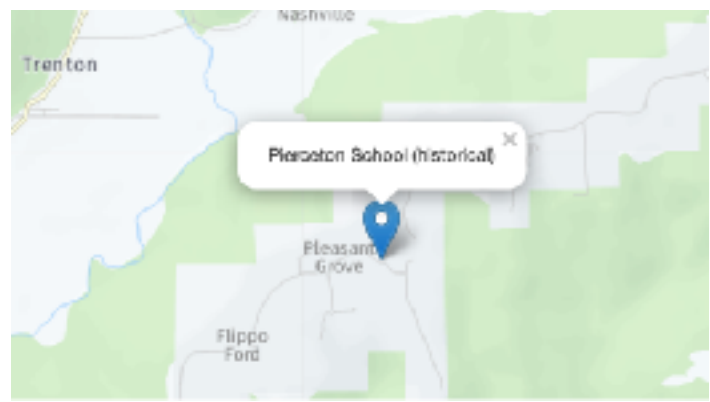

Notice is hereby given that a special election will be held in  
**Pierceton District No. 86,**  
 at **School House**  
 Jackson County, Alabama, on the 26th day of July 1928, for the purpose of determining whether or not a special tax shall be levied and collected annually, at the rate of 30 cents on each one hundred dollars worth of taxable property in  
**Pierceton District No. 86,**  
 in said county, and to be continued

for a period of two years from September 30, 1928, the same to be for the support of the public schools within said district. The boundaries of said district are as follows:

Beginning at SW corner of section 5, Tp 4, R 4; thence north 1 mile; thence east 1 mile; thence north 1 1/2 miles; thence east 2 miles; thence south 1/2 mile; thence east 1/2 mile; thence south 2 miles; thence west 3 1/2 miles to point of beginning. Said district contains sections 32, 34, the west 1/2 of section 35, the south 1/2 of 27, the south 1/2 of 28, Tp 3, R 4. Also sections 3, 4, 5, and the west 1/2 of section 2, Tp 4, R 4. All of said district being in Jackson County, Alabama.

## Pierceton School

Pierceton School is located about nine miles northwest of Larkinsville. Six grades are taught. This school serves the Pleasant Grove community.

The trustees of the school are L. T. West and S. H. West. The faculty consists of one teacher, Miss Elaine Bonannon.

The student body is as follows: first grade, 6; second grade, 7; third grade, 12; fourth grade, 5; fifth grade, 4; sixth grade, 3. The total enrollment is 40 students with an average attendance of 32.5 per cent.

The school is a one-room building. There is an outdoor toilet for the girls, but none for the boys.

The playground consists of one acre.

The building is in such condition that a new building should be provided.

There is a need for more desks, bookcases, new rest room for girls, a rest room for the boys new stove and electricity.

We hope to accomplish some of these improvements during the year.
