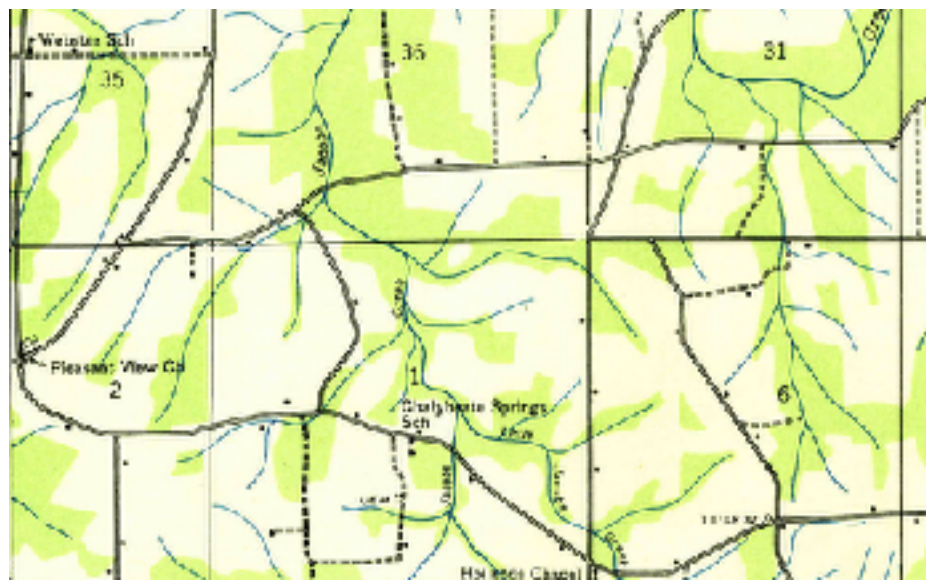

 Webster School District No. 109 in said county, shall be levied and collected annually for a period of 7 years from the 30th day of Sept. 1923, for the support of the public schools within said
 Webster School District No. 109 in said County. The boundaries of said
 Webster School District No. 109 are as follows:
 Beginning at the North East corner of Section 25, Tp. 4, Range 7; Thence West 1 mile; thence South 1/2 mile; thence West 1 mile; thence South 2 miles; thence East 1 1/2 miles; thence North 1/2 mile; thence East 1/2 mile; thence North 1/2 mile; thence East 1/2 mile; thence North 1 1/2 miles; thence West 1/2 mile; thence North 1/2 mile to point of beginning.
 Said district contains: The W 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 25; all of Sec. 26; the S 1/4 of Sec. 27; all of Secs. 24 and 35; the W 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 30; the W 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 36; all in Tp. 4, R. 7, East.
 Also the N 1/2 of Sec. 3; the NW 1/4 of Sec. 2; the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Sec. 2, all in Tp. 5, Range 7, East, in Jackson county, Ala.
