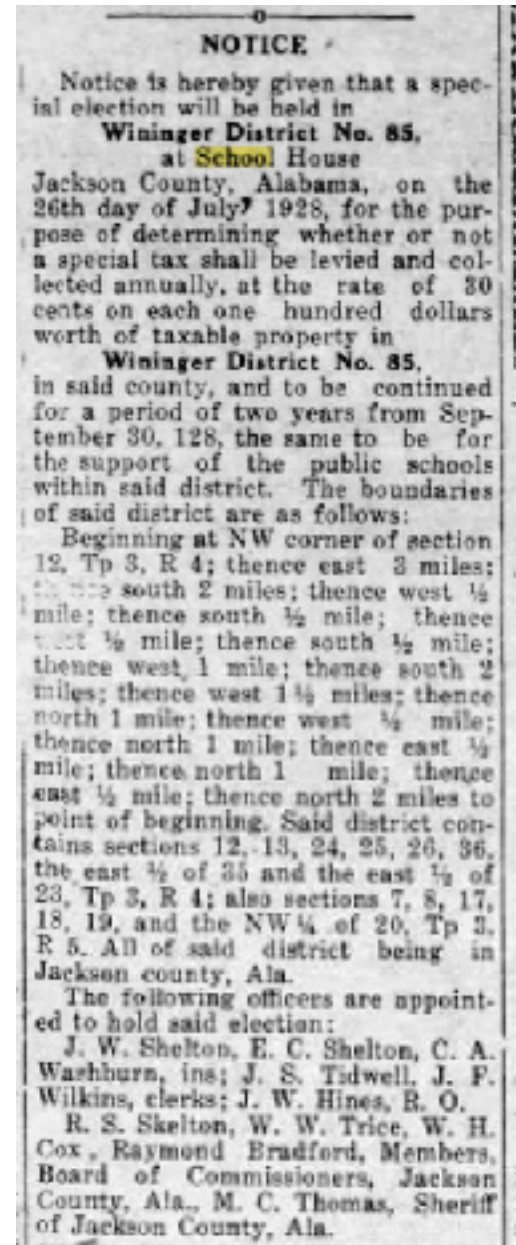
1923-1924 Mrs. W. H. Robinson, 3 months at \$60

Consolidated with Clarksville until Federal Court ordered the Jackson County Board of Education to transport Winger students to Skyline Junior High.

**Jan 20, 1898 PA:** "They are talking about building a school house about half a mile north of the Disharoon houses near Winger."

**August 2, 1928 PA:** Month of August, notice of 3 mil election published. Winger passed the tax.



**Aug 2, 1951 PA:** "Sale of School Property. Notice is hereby given that the Jackson County Board of Education will accept sealed bid until 12 o'clock noon August 31, 1951 on the school property listed below....Winninger School Building and 2 acres of land...Signed Delbert Hicks, Superintendent of Education."

This is Winninger Methodist School. It burned in the 1930s
