Roger Parrish leaves his book satchel to Jason and Jerome Walsh. They can take turns carrying it;

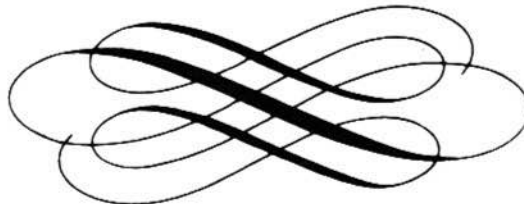
