

THE ALABAMA GULLATTS SEPTEMBER 2004

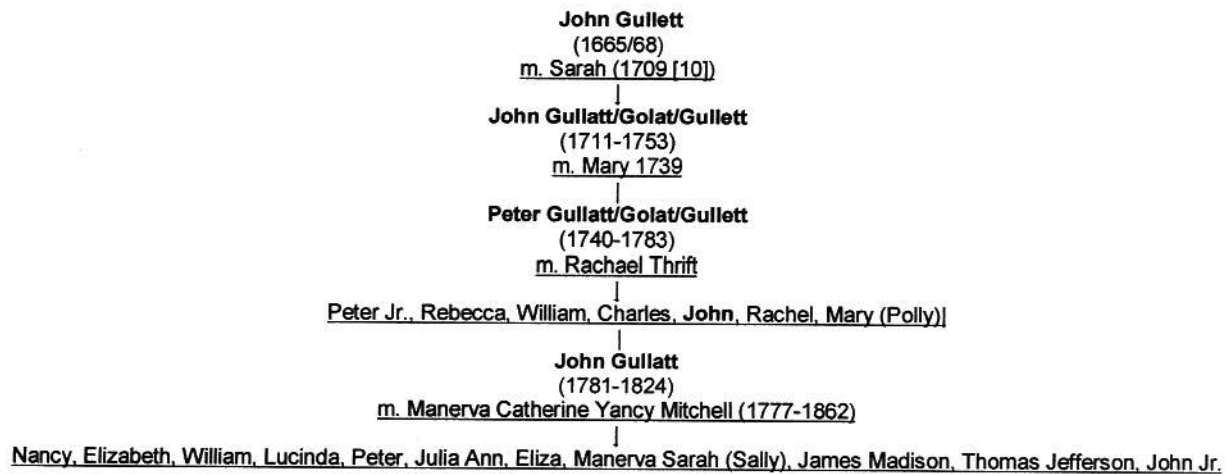
Most sources seem to agree that the first documentation of Gullatts in America involved John Gullatt who lived in Cecil County Maryland in the late 17th century. Probably the name "Gullatt" (and its variations – Gullett, Gallett, Golat, etc.) was originally of French origin. The first Gullatts may have been French Huguenots who left France because of religious persecution. No one seems to know when they left France or if they settled elsewhere before migrating to America. Since all of the given names of the early Gullatts are Anglo Saxon, it seems logical to assume that they stopped in England before coming to America and settling in Maryland.

Gullatts are now found throughout the country from New England to California. (Note: By pure circumstance 9th and 10th generation Gullatts currently live in Cecil County Maryland close to St. Stephens Parish Church where the early records of the Gullatts were found.)

This is an attempt to gather information about the "Alabama Gullatts".

(Twins)**



John Gullatt (1711 -1753) married Mary ? about 1739. Their son Peter was born in Cecil County Maryland in June of 1740.

Peter Gullatt (1740-1783) became a master blacksmith and married Rachael Thrift. There is a letter of indenture dated 1770 authorizing Peter to train 2 slaves as blacksmiths for George Washington and John Custis (Washington's step-son). At some point, they moved their family to Truro Parish, Fairfax County Virginia where their son John was born in 1781. Peter and Rachael had 7 children:

- Peter Gullatt, Jr. (1769 – 1840). Married Rachael Huguley and had 10 children.
- Rebecca Gullatt (1771 – 1840). Married John Huguley and had 7 children.
- William Gullatt (1773 – after 1830). Name of wife is unknown. Had 5 children.
- Charles Gullatt (1775 – after 1850). Name of 1st wife is unknown, but they had 7 children. Married Ellenor Sinclair in Nov 1835.
- **John Gullatt** (1777 – 1824). Married Manerva Catherine Yancy Mitchell, had 12 children. Moved to Alabama about 1815.
- Rachael Gullatt (1779 – 1816). Married George Huguley and had 5 children
- Mary (Polly)

John Gullatt (1781 – 1824), also a blacksmith, married **Manerva Catherine Yancy Mitchell** (1777 – 1862) and they moved to Jackson County Alabama. Family tradition says that Catherine's maternal grand mother was an American Indian named "Sabacah" Birdwell.

The Gullatts and the Huguleys moved from Virginia to Lincoln County GA about 1800. John and Manerva had a 200 acre farm on Soap Creek & another farm of 250 acres in Gwinnett Co. GA. The date that they arrived in Alabama is uncertain, but the settlement of Catherine's mother's estate in 1817 mentions that Catherine has married John "Golatt" and they are currently living in Alabama. They were truly some of the first white settlers in the area.


John and Catherine are the source of the Alabama Gullatts. Their union produced somewhere between 10 and 17 children. John died in 1824, but Catherine lived until 1862.

They and their children were farmers and set about acquiring land. At least 23 Land Patents were granted to John, Catherine and their children and they probably bought more land by private sale.

The Children of John and Catherine Gullatt included:

- Lucinda b. 1810 in GA, m. Samuel Thompson – 8 children
- Peter b. 1808 in GA. d. 1858/59 in Jackson County AL – unmarried.
- Julia Ann b. 1815 d in MO, m. 1). Israel Boon (e) 1830 McMinn County TN – 8 children, 2). Jessie Boon(e) (Israel's brother) in MO
- Eliza b. 1813 in AL, m. Daniel A Thompson – 6 children
- Manerva Sarah (Sally) b. 1817 in AL, m. John Gant (Gaunt) – 6 children
- James Madison Gullatt (Twin of Thomas Jefferson) b. April 15, 1820 in AL, d. June 23, 1906 in AL. m. 1). Juliet Clark (sister of Martha Elizabeth who married Thomas Jefferson) – 1 daughter. 2). Malissa Payne Harper – 14 children

- Thomas Jefferson Gullatt (Twin of James Madison) b. April 15, 1820 in AL, d. April 5, 1898 in AL. 5 wives – 1). Martha Elizabeth Clark – 7 children, 2). Mrs. Sarah Elizabeth Browning Campbell – 3 children, 3). Malinda Privett, 4). Rachael Watson, 5). Mrs. Ollie Tomlinson

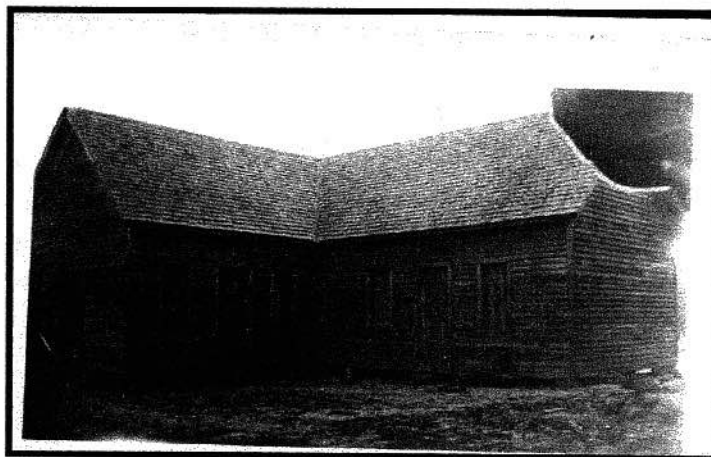

Twins born on April 15 1820 to John Gullatt and Minerva Catherine Yancy Mitchell Gullatt in Jackson County Alabama.

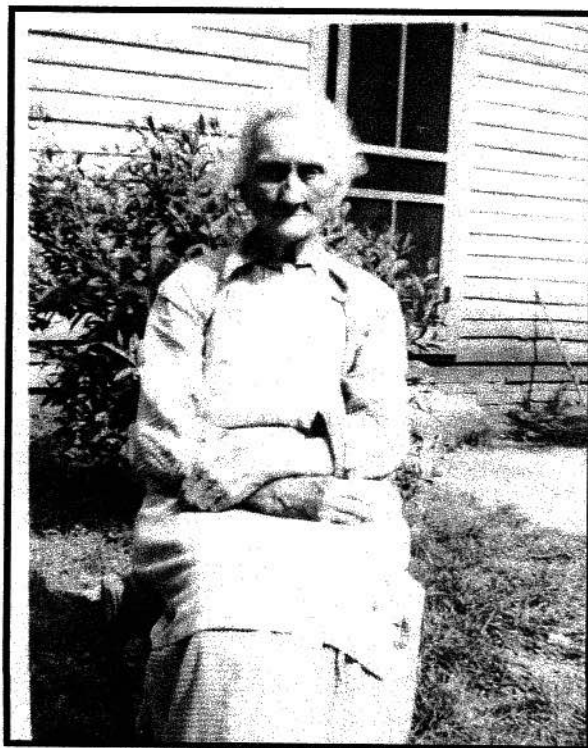
James Madison (April 15, 1820 – June 23, 1906) died in Jackson County and is buried in Pleasant Hill Cemetery in Dutton, Alabama. In 1841 he married Juliet Clark (sister of Martha Elizabeth who married his twin). They had one daughter (Julieta b. Oct. 26, 1842). With his second wife, Malissa Payne Harper (b. Jan. 29, 1832 in Madison County AL; d. June 11, 1900 in Jackson County AL), he had 14 children.

James Madison Gullatt was a lieutenant in the Florida Indian War, served in the Mexican War and was, for a time, a Texas Ranger. He was a long time tax assessor for Jackson County Alabama and a tax commissioner. He was a contractor, an ox-drawn freighter and a farmer.

His daughter, Julieta (with Juliet Clark) (26 Oct 1842 – 14 June 1886). Married Henry H. Coulson and had 6 children.

Hetty Elizabeth Gullatt, Mt. Airy, NC 1952

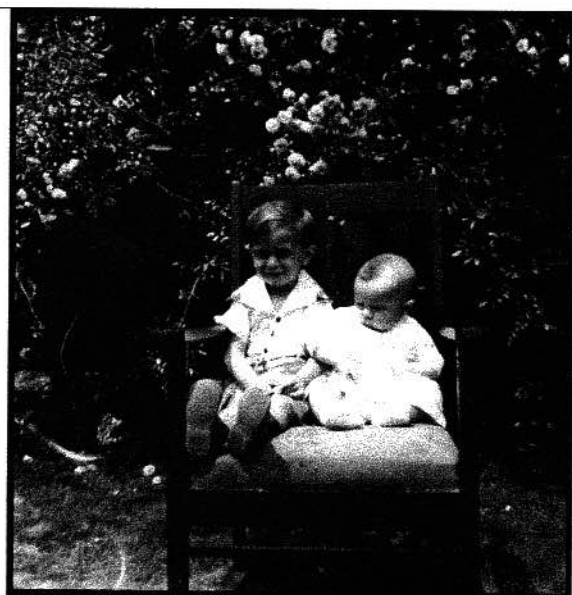

Thomas Jefferson Gullatt died on April 5, 1898 in Jackson County AL. He had 5 wives and 10 children. He married Martha Elizabeth Clark in 1841; they had 7 children. On January 29, 1865 he married Mrs. Sara Elizabeth Browning Campbell; they had 3 children. His other wives were: Malinda Privett (Sept. 17, 1872, Rachael Watson (Aug. 23, 1877) and Mrs. Ollie Tomlinson (Nov. 16, 1892).

Thomas Jefferson, as well as farming, ran a "poor house" in Hollywood, Jackson County, Alabama and was a tax collector for Scottsboro. James Madison served as both tax assessor and tax collector for Jackson County.

A Jackson Man Suddenly Becomes a Millionaire

"About eighteen months ago, on the farm of Thomas J. Gullatt, located on what is known as the 'poor mountain,' distant about three miles from Bellefonte station, there was discovered what was thought to be a coal vein. Not too much attention was paid to it, as coal abounds all over Jackson County. Mr. Gullatt, the owner of the land, kept on having it investigated, when lo! and behold, it turns up to be a gold and silver mine according to thought-to-be competent assayists. Mr. Gullatt sent specimens of the ore to four assayists, three of whom pronounced it gold and silver.

We are permitted to publish these two certificates: Sodalite, Mo., Jan. 18, 1883. Mr. Thos. J. Gullatt:-Dear Sir, Your letter with samples of ore received. You will please find report of assay enclosed. I find no copper or lead-the latter is very seldom if ever found in that kind of ore, copper is usually present, but in very minute quantities. No other metals were present except a little antimony. -J.Q. Simmons.

The assayist at White Pine, California says: "This is to certify that samples of ore said to be from Alabama Lode, left by Mr. Thos. J. Gullatt, contains silver, 4 ounces, gold 1/2 ounce per ton of two thousand pounds."

Thus a poor man suddenly becomes a millionaire. Mr. Gullatt was interviewed by the CITIZEN last Saturday, and we found him very happy over his mines. He says there are 280 acres on his place, 200 of it being mineral. His land lies on either side of the mountain, the distance across the mountain being 400 yards. The thickness of the vein is 3 feet, 3 inches, there being a stratum of black flint and white pebble between it. Mr. Gullatt estimates the value of his mine at five million dollars, and is only awaiting some capitalist to buy him out, or make some proposition to have the mines worked.

Mr. Gullatt has been living on his place about thirteen years. He was raised in this county, is a brother of Tax Assessor Gullatt, and is about fifty-five or sixty years old. He has been a poor man all of his life, and the indications are now that if he is not made a millionaire, he has a small fortune which will make him comfortable the balance of his life.

Mr. Gullatt lives eight miles northeast of Scottsboro." (*The Citizen, J. Armstrong, Editor.*)

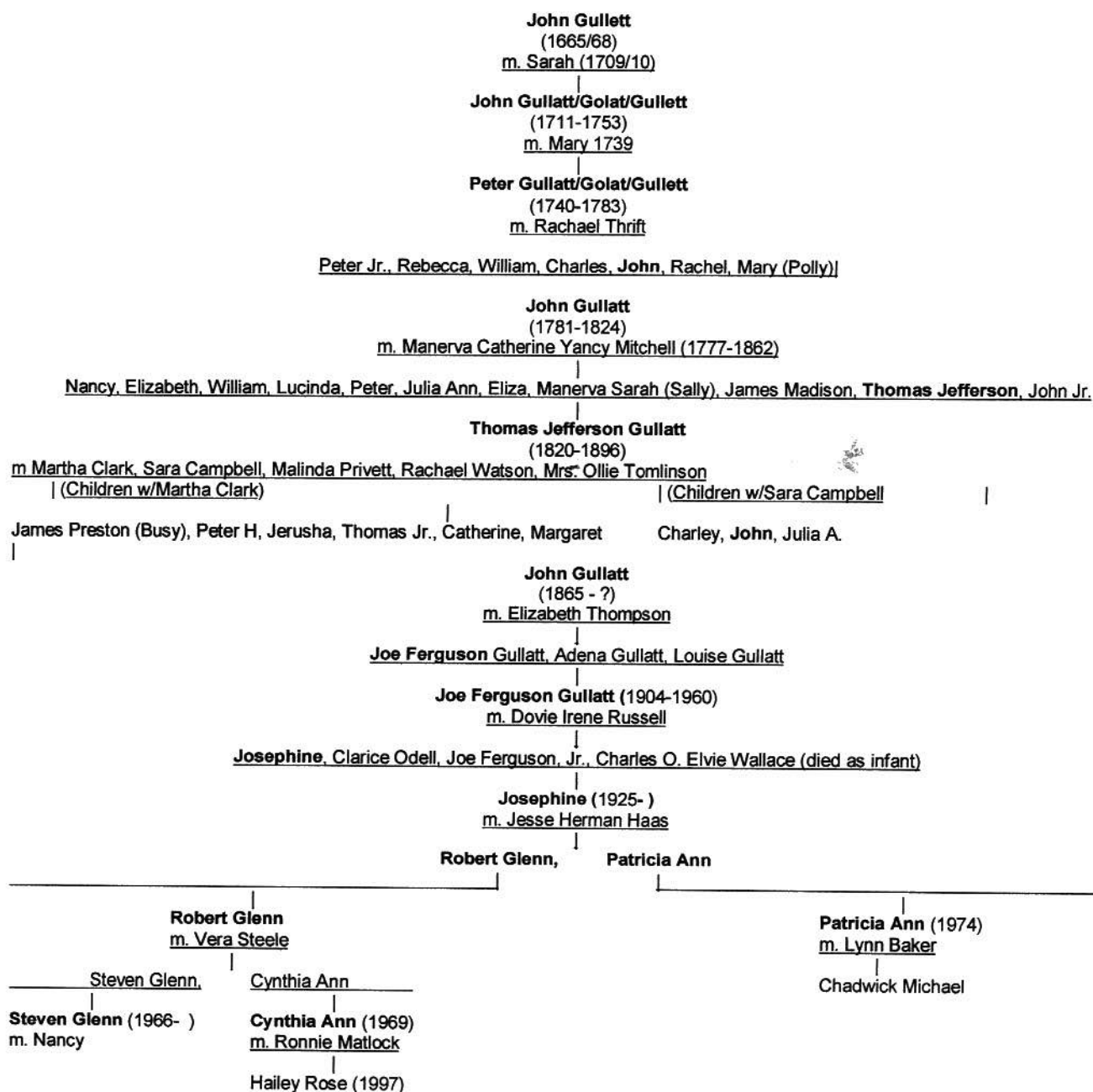

John Gullatt was born March 31, 1865 to Thomas Jefferson Gullatt and Sarah Elizabeth Browning Campbell. He was a half brother of James Preston (Busy) Gullatt.

He married Elizabeth Thompson (b. April 2, 1875 at Goosepond). Thomas Jefferson Gullatt raised Elizabeth and her sister, Molly, in the Poor House as their mother died when Elizabeth was 5 years old. Elizabeth and Molly were the grandchildren of Thomas Jefferson and James Madison's sister, Lucinda (b. 1810/11 in GA) who married Samuel Thompson (b. 1803/04.) Their son Fowler (Farley?) married Jane Morgan May 5, 1872. Both parents died prior to 1880 as they are listed in the 1880 census as living with Lucinda

Elizabeth and John had 8 children: Four children, Alice, Ellie, Parlie and Ruby died as children.

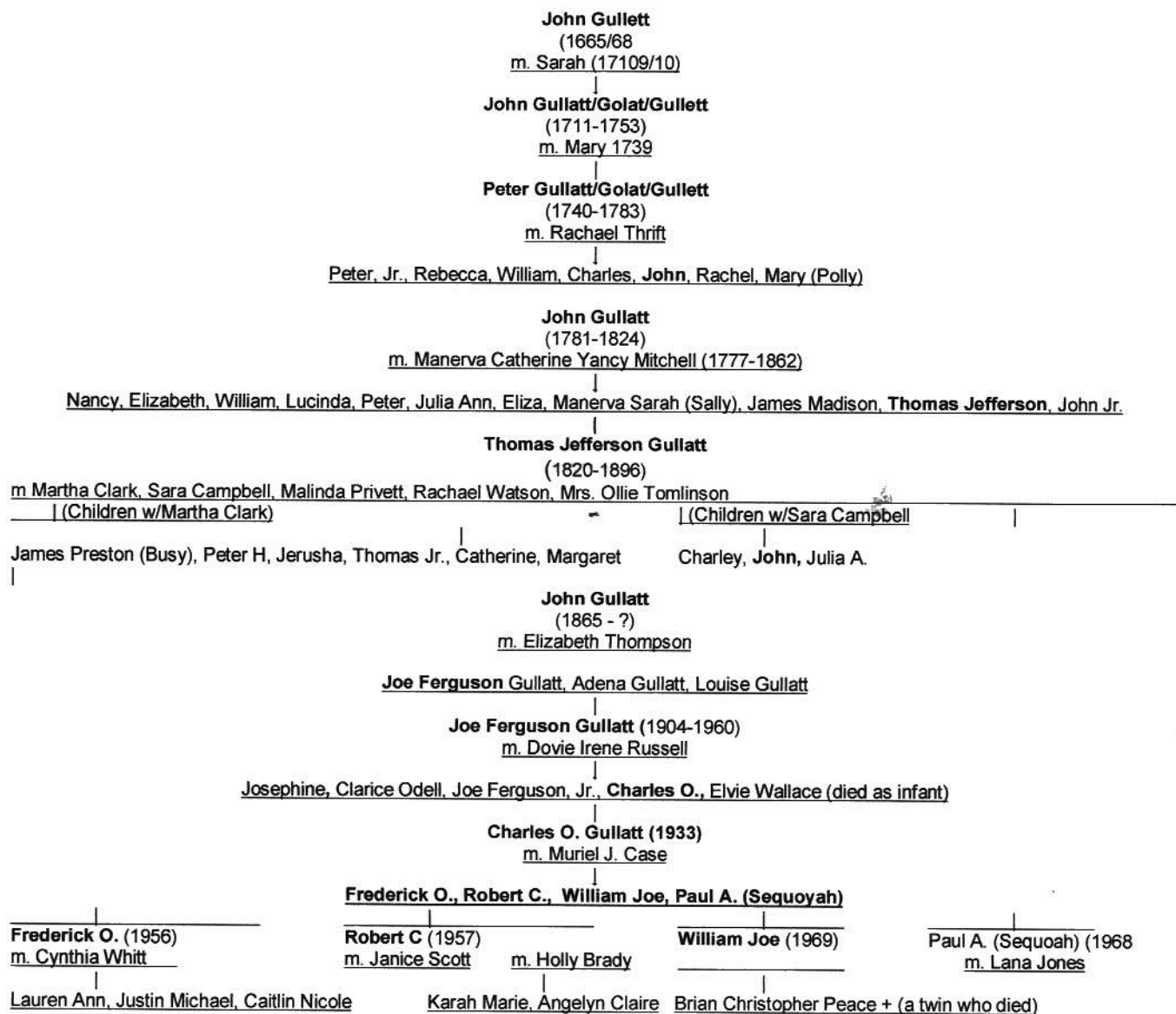

John Frank (Frank) Gullatt and Nora Lee Howard were married in Birmingham and then returned to Hollywood, Alabama where John Frank farmed and ran a general store. They lived in a home (on a 120-acre farm) near the store in Hollywood. They had 3 boys who went to the Hollywood school.

In 1918 Frank decided to purchase more land and conceived the idea of rebuying farmland that had once belonged to the Gullatts. Using friends as intermediaries, he purchased almost 1000 acres (including "Poor House Mountain") at the very end of County Road 34. They continued to live in Hollywood – Nora Lee was a city girl and the "queen of chit-chat" – but farmed both farms (now known as "The Big Farm" and "The Little Farm").

In 1929/30 at the height of the depression, money was in short supply. Frank, Nora Lee and their 3 boys left Alabama for the north where they joined Nora Lee's brothers in establishing a chain of dry cleaning stores, "Howard Cleaners – We Clean Everything but the Kids". They kept the farms as a security blanket.

The two older boys, Roy and Howard struck out with their own dry cleaning businesses in Baltimore and Cleveland. The youngest, Walker Frank – just 18, went to New Britain Connecticut with Frank and Nora Lee. It was a good business for the depression. People could afford cleaners – not new clothes. They were a success.

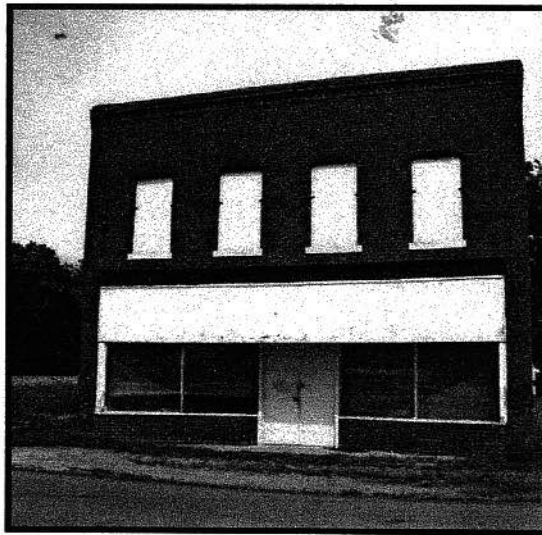
In 1934 Frank became ill and went to Florida to recuperate (one of the Howard brothers had an establishment in St. Petersburg) where he died. He was buried in Birmingham and Nora Lee returned to Birmingham to be near her family.

PASSING OF FRANK GULLATT

News was received here Monday of the death of Frank Gullatt which occurred in Florida Sunday. The news of his death was a severe shock to his many friends in Jackson county. Mr. Gullatt was reared at Hollywood and lived most of his life at that place where he was engaged in the mercantile and farming business. He was a very successful business man and took an active interest in the affairs of his community and county. He was highly respected for his honesty and fairness in business dealings and for his generosity.

Several years ago he removed with his family to New York and Connecticut where he was a member of the Howard Dry Cleaners, a nationally known syndicate. He had made good financially with the business. His many friends here were not apprised of his illness, but have learned since his death that he has been ill for several months and was in Florida in an effort to regain his health. His remains were brought to Birmingham for burial Wednesday.

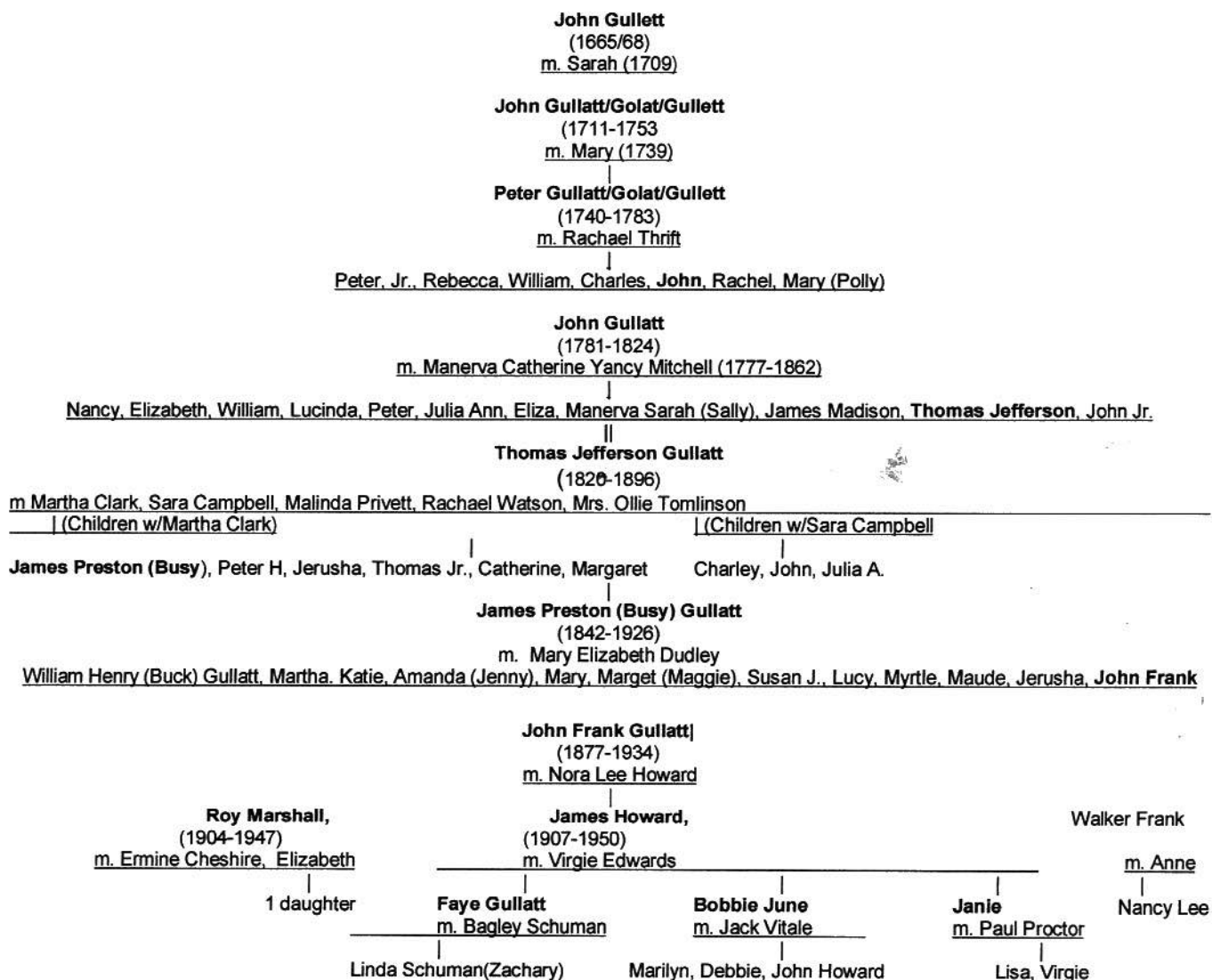

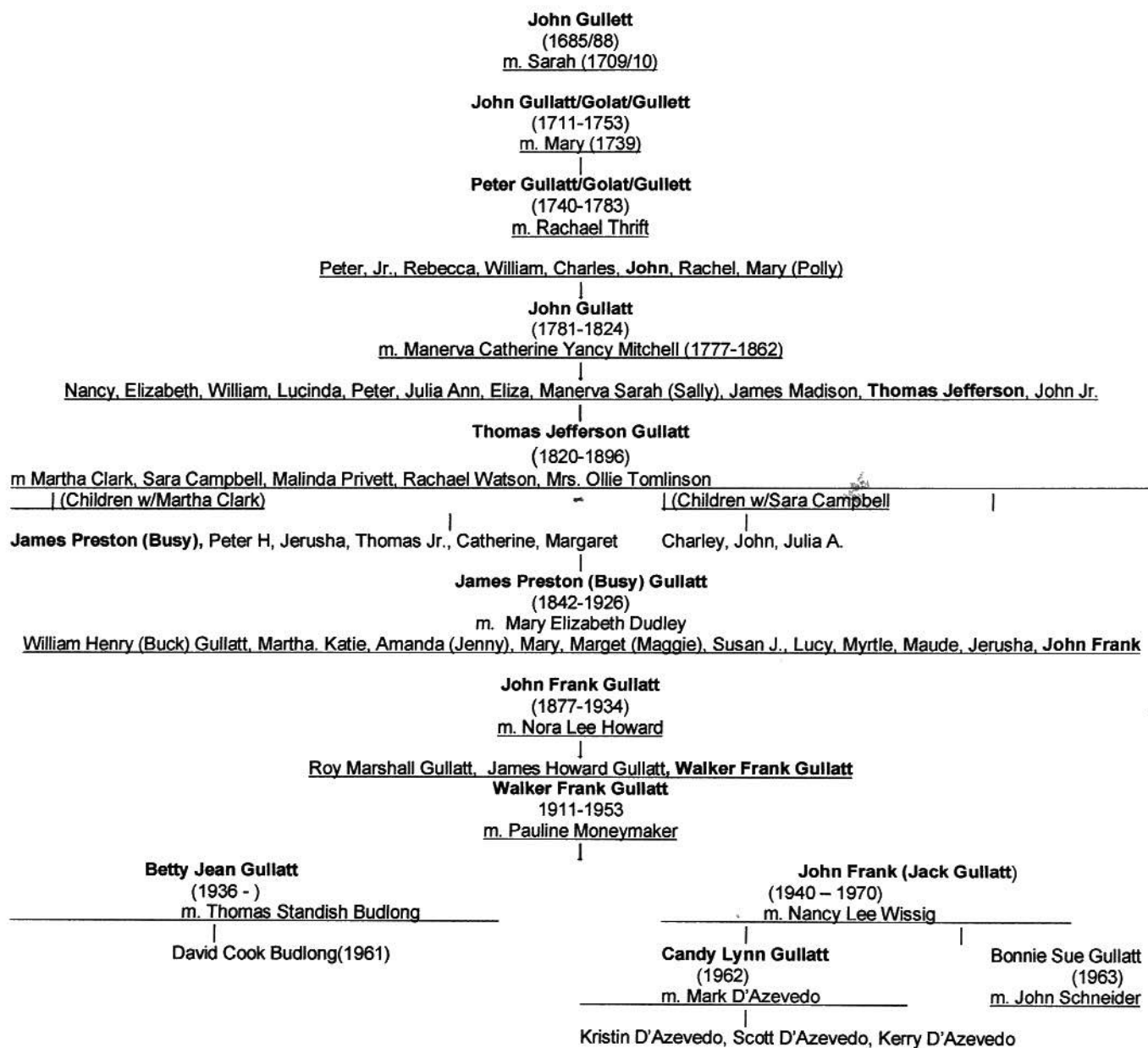

Walker Frank Gullatt was born on May 11, 1911 in Jackson County Alabama; he died on April 21, 1953 in New Britain CT. He is buried in Connecticut with his wife, Pauline, son Jack (my brother) and Pauline's parents Earl and Beatrice Moneymaker.

As a very young child, Walker Gullatt was involved in a hunting accident. A shotgun severed most of the nerves in his right leg. As a consequence he couldn't participate in active sports or do heavy farm work. At the age of 10 or so, he had completed all of the education that the Hollywood school system offered and Frank and Nora Lee sent him to boarding school in Boaz Alabama.

When Walker graduated from the Boaz school, the country was entering the depression; money was in short supply. The Frank Gullatt Family packed up and moved north to join Nora Lee's Howard brothers in starting a chain of dry cleaning stores. The two older boys started businesses of their own, Walker, just 18, went with his parents to New Britain Connecticut.

In 1933 Walker married Pauline Moneymaker who was born on August 3, 1913 in Confederate Kentucky. Her father, Earl, had been a farmer and the head of the laundry at Paducah's prison. They too had come north because of the depression.

In 1935 Frank died and Nora Lee returned to Alabama and the Howard family in Birmingham.

Walker and Pauline stayed in Connecticut and developed the most successful business in the chain. They added a laundry to the dry cleaning plant and, with the main plant in New Britain, had as many as 50 branch stores (from Hartford to New Haven).

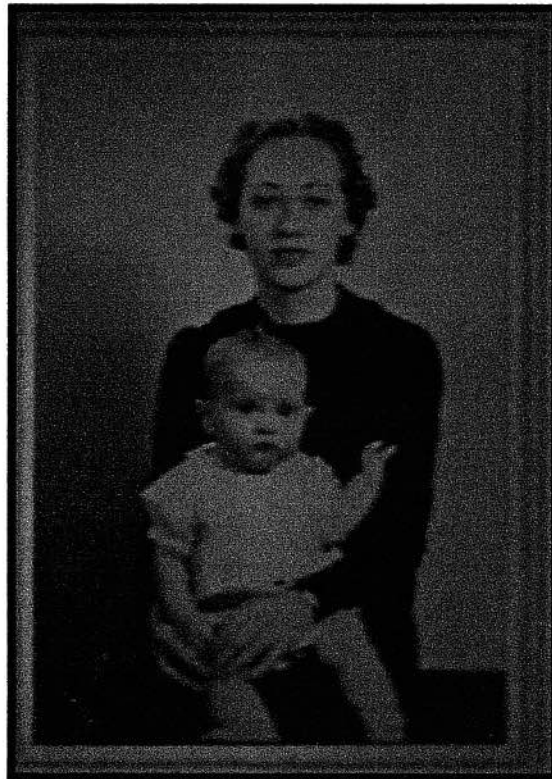
Walker never learned to cope with New England winters. Every year his family took a break from about December 1st to February 1st and headed south. The dry cleaning business was run by daily calls to Pauline's father. Walker and Pauline visited the Hollywood farm and spent some time on the beach in Florida.

Walker loved sports, but, because of his right leg, was unable to participate. Instead he owned a racing stable that raced from New York State to Florida – another reason to winter in Florida – and sponsored minor league baseball and basketball teams in Connecticut.

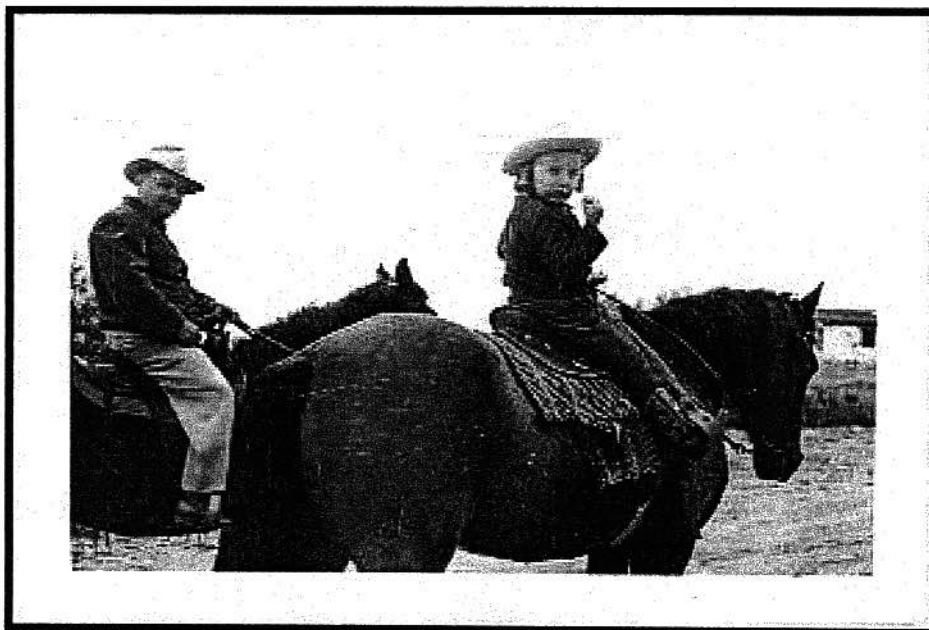

They have one son, David Cook Budlong born on December 25, 1961 in Burbank CA.

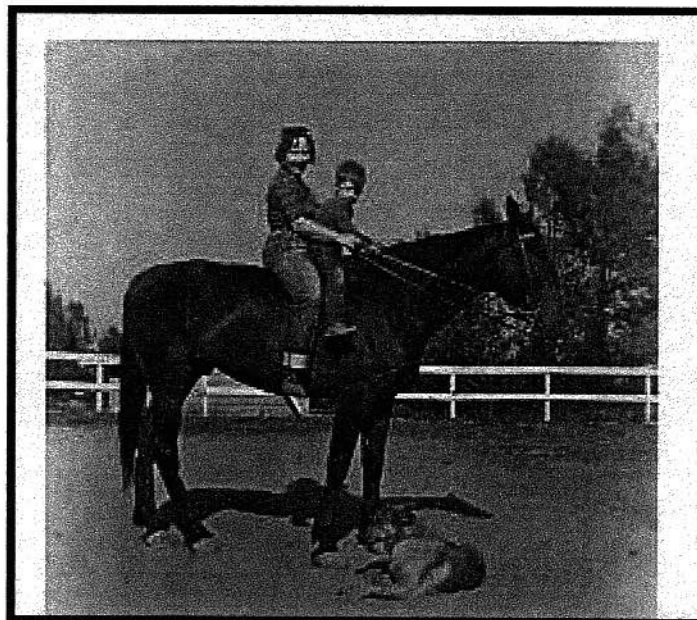
