FORWARD

The enclosed records are taken from the Field Books of the surveyors for the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) when preparations were being made to construct the Guntersville Dam near Guntersville, Alabama. These field books contain the information as recorded. No attempt has been made to correct the spelling or other information.

TVA's proceedure was to find relatives of each grave located in the flood plain for the reservoir. They constructed a plat map of each cemetery showing every grave that was possible to locate. As many of these are not marked and no one could be found who knew a name for the deceased, they were marked as "Unknown". When a grave was known, the next of kin was consulted and a form was signed by them to either remove the remains and re-inter the remains in another cemetery or a form signed to leave the remains where originally buried. These forms are still on file in the Mapping and Survey Division of TVA in Chattanooga.

The re-internment records of TVA are frequently known and widely circulated, but few know of the Field Books which contains a great wealth of genealogical data. It is for this latter purpose that this manuscript is prepared and it is hope that you will find the information to meet your needs.

INTRODUCTION

The Guntersville Reservoir surveys disclosed the existence in that area of thrity-five cemeteries, thirty-three of which occupied sites subsequently purchased by the Authority. Of these, fourteen containing about 250 graves were below pool level or were cut off by the reservoir from highway access.

Individual contracts to relocate sixty-eight of the graves and to allow one hundred twenty-two to remain were signed with relatives of the deceased. Reinterments were made in six nearby cemeteries, most of these during July 1937, a few in October 1938. The necessary surveys and grave identification work, preliminary to removal, had been caried on intermittently since the beginning of reservoir surveys in February 1935.

Policies and procedures governing Guntersville grave removal were the same as those developed and found successful on the Norris, Wheeler, and Pickwick Landing Projects, except that here all graves were removed by Authority forces, none by private undertakers. Those handling the work for the Authority had gained experience with grave removal procedures on the previous projects and the Guntersville grave removal appears to have been executed with complete satisfaction to the families of the deceased.

The total cost was about \$7,000.00 which included the surveying, mapping, investigative and identification work, contracting with relatives, and the actual removal and reinterment work.

#5 RUSSELL PUBLIC CEMETERY

This cemetery located on the property of J. G. Russell in Section 20, TWP 8 S, R 3 E, Marshall County, Ala. Elevation 590 feet. Final action on this cemetery now pending. Mr. J. G. Russell owner of the land adjoining the cemetery, will not permit the TVA to enter this property to remove any graves. He states that his reasons for so doing is that the TVA has not yet acquired his property and that his wife is ill and he does not want any operations in the cemetery, which is located near his residence, until he has moved from property. Mr. Russell is the nearest relative to 11 of the deceased in the cemetery and he states that "...he does not want them moved..." but he will not sign any permit for them to remain. contacted nearest relatives of 17 of the deceased and executed permits for 11 to remain and 6 to be moved to the Clear Springs Cemetery.
